What currency are you starting with?

- A) CZK (Czech crowns)
- B) EUR (euro)

A: I'm starting with CZK

This option is suitable for people who do not want to deal with currency exchange or want the easiest entry possible.

A1) I want maximum simplicity (minimum steps)

Use: **Anycoin**

Process:

1. Bank (CZK)
2. Anycoin
3. Buy USDT/USDC/POL
4. Withdraw to wallet (verify network)

Pros:

- Czech company, Czech support.
- Very simple.
- Suitable for complete beginners.

Cons:

- Higher fees (spread).

A2) I want a better price, but I stay in CZK

Use: **Coinmate**

Process:

1. Bank (CZK)
2. Coinmate
3. Buying crypto
4. Withdrawal to your own wallet or to another exchange

Pros:

- Czech Stock Exchange.
- Better prices than the exchange office.
- Regulated environment.

Cons:

- Smaller selection of coins.
- Polygon mesh support is missing.
- necessary next step (moving to another exchange - for example mexc.com for an efficient and cheap network change)

What currency are you starting with?

B: I'm starting with EUR

B1) I want the best price/performance ratio

Use: Binance

Process:

1. Banka (SEPA EUR)
2. Binance
3. Buy USDT/USDC/POL
4. Selection on Polygon mesh
5. Transfer to wallet

Pros:

- Lowest fees.
- The greatest liquidity.

Cons:

- More complex interface for complete novices.
- There is no Czech support.

B2) I want a simpler environment, EU regulation

Use: Battlefield

Process:

1. Banka (SEPA EUR)
2. Battle
3. Buy USDT/USDC/POL
4. Withdrawal to wallet

Pros:

- Clear interface.
- EU regulation.
- Simple to use.

Cons:

- Higher fees than Binance.
- Less advanced features.
